

## White Wines

- 6 Paul Mas Claude Val Blanc France 175ml glass £3.25 75cl bottle £11.95**  
Soft ripe tropical fruit, white peach and ripe apple is combined on the palate with restrained honeyed banana and gooseberry notes. Dry refreshing clean and certainly persistent flavours.
- 7 Embleme d' Argent Colombard France 175 ml glass £3.95 £13.95**  
Round and soft on the palate, supporting a good concentration of apple and peach flavours.
- 8 Broken Rock Chenin Blanc South Africa 175ml Glass £3.95 £14.95**  
Fresh and crisp yet with a soft roundness. Citric lemon, almost baked in character with a subtle herbaceous touch.
- 9 Astica Sauvignon Blanc/Semillon Argentina 175ml Glass £4.15 £15.95**  
A vibrant zippy tang of citrus lemon and lime fruit and herbaceous flavours, followed by a mouth-watering finish, provide instant appeal in this wine.
- 10 Alto Pampas Viognier Mendoza Argentina £15.95**  
Fresh fruit aroma and flavour of quince, pear and a touch of apricot. All presented in a soft texture and not too dry. A perfect match to spicy food.
- 11 Trulli Pinot Grigio Pavia Italy £15.95**  
Moderately dry on the palate, light in alcohol and soft in texture, yet it is fresh and clean, showing citric lemon notes, apple and a touch of ripe peach.
- 12 Black River Organic Semillon Argentina £16.95**  
Bright pale yellow. Intense fig and fresh melon, with green apple aromas. Smooth on the palate. A well balanced and pure dry white.
- 13 Fairfields Sauvignon Blanc Marlborough New Zealand £17.95**  
Boasting complexity in aroma and flavour with focussed characteristics. Herbaceous notes of grass and nettle combine with lemon lime and gooseberry fruit and support a host of riper tropical characters. Fresh vibrant with great elegance and poise.
- 14 Chablis Emile Petit Brocard 2008 France £19.95**  
From a very respected grower, Jean Marc Brocard. The wine has all the character of top quality Chablis. Fine minerality, restrained citrus fruit, firm structure and a bone dry finish

## Red Wines

**15 Paul Mas Claude Val Rouge France 175ml glass £3.25 75cl bottle £11.95**

A blend of Southern Rhone grape varieties showing pure bright fresh red berry and ripe plum character from added Merlot. The palate brings bags of forest berry fruit red cherry, blackberry and a touch of pepper spice.

**16 Embleme d'Argent Merlot France 175ml glass £3.95 £13.95**

A great value red wine. Well made, structured with soft fine grained tannin, full body and abundant juicy cherry and ripe dark plum fruit. A good medium length.

**17 Pleno Tempranillo Navarra Spain 175ml Glass £3.95 £14.95**

Made from 100% Tempranillo grapes. A smooth red, with good concentration of ripe juicy berry fruit. Medium in body, moderate in alcohol, with good length.

**18 Las Toscas Cabernet-Carmenere Chile 175ml Glass £4.50 £15.95**

An unusual and interesting blend of grape varieties. Firm yet soft, blackcurrant and dark red plum fruit prevail, with notes of chocolate and sweet spices on the finish.

**19 Vignes De Nicole Cabernet Sauvignon/Syrah VDP d'Oc France £15.95**

An excellent crafted red. Structured and elegant, gamey savoury notes harmonised perfectly with blackcurrant liquorice and pepper spiced blackberry fruit. The tannins are supple and the wine is deceptively intense with a very long dark berried spicy finish.

**20 Tortoiseshell Bay Shiraz-Barbera Australia £15.95**

A very fresh Shiraz boasting bags of juicy blackberry and cherry fruit. Barbera grapes bring a light bodied juicy freshness, with soft tannins and lingering finish.

**21 Black River Organic Malbec Argentina £16.95**

A carefully crafted example made by the expert, Humberto Canale. Opulent blackberry and blueberry fruit, integrated with soft tannins. A super smooth, refined Malbec,

**22 Rioja Vega Crianza 2006 Spain £18.95**

A well structured example, which combines pronounced blackberry and ripe cherry fruit with a hint of vanilla. Lovely soft texture, smooth tannins and long length prevail.

**23 Chateau Tour St Bonnet 2005 Haut Medoc Bordeaux France £29.95**

From an excellent vintage and reputed source. With good structure and finesse, there are all the hallmark blackcurrant cassis notes from Cabernet Sauvignon balanced with mouth filling fleshy ripe Merlot. Being from the 2005 vintage it is now showing some maturity with fine cedar wood and leather notes and soft supple tannins.

## Sparkling and Champagne Wine

**1 Toso Sparkling Brut NV Mendoza Argentina £21.95**

Made using the same grapes for Champagne. Dry with a light refreshing and zesty nature, citric notes of green apples and lemons prevail.

**2 Moet Chandon NV Champagne France £37.95**

Dry in style with a distinctive flowery aroma and yeasty character.

**3 Bollinger Special Cuvee Brut NV Champagne France £59.95**

A full bodied and masculine Champagne with high proportions of Pinot Noir, giving real depth and dimension.

## Rose Wines

**4 Lutzville Shiraz Rose South Africa 175ml Glass £3.95 £14.95**

Bright red colour is supported by fresh strawberry and raspberry flavours. Dry, light in body, with clean, crisp acidity. Appealing, easy drinking rose wine.

**5 Campana Pinot Grigio Rosato Veneto Italy £16.95**

Salmon pink in colour this wine has a typical delicate and interesting nature, providing light raspberry and redcurrant notes, together with a subtle wild flower.
